## CITY OF BURLINGTON FIRE STATION NO. 6 TO RUN FIRST CALLS

BURLINGTON, NC— Burlington's 6<sup>th</sup> fire station will begin operations on Thursday, September 22<sup>nd</sup> at 0800 hours. A fire engine, ladder truck and Battalion Chief's vehicle will operate out of this station, staffed by seven personnel a day.

The 14,538 square foot Station No. 6 is located at 3644 Bonnar Bridge Parkway.

The station will officially be dedicated at 10:00am on Thursday, October 6<sup>th</sup>. The Dedication Ceremony will be followed immediately by an open house until 12:00pm.
