Burlington Police Invite Potential Recruits to Learn More

The Burlington Police Department will host two information sessions on September 30, 2017

BURLINGTON, NC— On Saturday, September 30, the Burlington Police Department (BPD) will open its doors to potential recruits for two two-hour employment information sessions. The sessions will take place at 10:00am and 2:00pm and will be held in the Emergency Operations Center of the Burlington Police Department, located at 267 West Front Street in downtown Burlington. The sessions are open to anyone considering a career in law enforcement including recent graduates, officers moving laterally, or individuals considering a career change.

Employment information sessions will include information about the BPD hiring process, benefits packages, special units, and available opportunities for advancement. Participants will also have the opportunity to meet active BPD officers and to ask any questions they may have.

Captain Mark Rascoe expressed his excitement for the upcoming employment information sessions saying, "we hire the best in Burlington and these sessions are one more way to help interested candidates decide if they have what it takes to apply to become a Burlington Police Officer. We want potential recruits to have the opportunity to learn what this department is all about before they decide to submit an application."
