Volunteers will meet at 849 Sharpe Road in the Mayco Bigelow Community Center parking lot. Trash bags and safety vests will be distributed before volunteers head out along the creek's edge to remove garbage and debris.

The Staley Creek Clean Up offers volunteers a chance to make a difference for the environment by promoting the protection of water quality, riparian ecosystems, and recreation uses within Alamance County. Come out and join us as we remove debris and other items from the stream that have an impact on water quality.
