Maple Avenue Closures 7/20 & 7/22 for to Water Valve Replacement

BURLINGTON, NC— Water & Sewer Pipe Maintenance will be replacing a water valve at the intersection of Maple Avenue and Spring Street in downtown Burlington. Due to this work, on Friday July 20, Maple Avenue, from Main Street to Spring Street, will be closed starting at 9am. This will allow staff to prepare the site for the value replacement scheduled for July 22. The work is estimated to take three hours, after which the road will be reopened.

The valve replacement will take place on Sunday, July 22, starting at 9am. During the valve replacement Maple Avenue, from Main Street to Spring Street, will be closed. In addition to road closure, water will be off in the area of Maple Avenue and Main Street on Sunday morning starting at 9 am and will remain off until the job is completed. Work is expected to last three hours. The residents and businesses in the area have been notified of the water outage.

Detours will be signed and drivers are asked to use caution.
