Burlington Police Department Asks For Resident Input: 2018 Community Survey

The Burlington Police Department is collaborating with the community to better understand the needs of the individuals we serve. The Department conducted a Community Survey previously in 2014. In order to continue to improve our strategies and actions over time and to be truly responsive to the goals of the community we serve, the Burlington Police Department is conducting a 2018 Community Survey.

A brief survey has been designed to gather the feedback of our Burlington residents regarding perceptions of safety in the community and trust in the police force. The survey is brief and the results will greatly assist us in planning for the future.

“For many years now our mission has been to build ‘Trust Through Transparency’. As the Police Chief, I am constantly seeking input and advice from the community as I direct the actions of our police officers. This survey is a great opportunity for me to better guide our staff as we protect the 55,000 people living and working in Burlington,” said Chief Smythe.

Citizen feedback is an invaluable tool for the Police Department. Much of the Department’s strategic plan and accreditation standards are informed by citizen feedback and help support the BPD’s commitment to meet community demands, reduce crime, enhance professionalism and build trust.
