Funeral and Visitation for Greensboro Police Officer Jared Franks

BURLINGTON, NC—

The Burlington Police Department, along with other local law enforcement agencies, will be assisting in the coordination of vehicular traffic during the visitation and funeral of Greensboro Police Officer Jared Franks.

The visitation will be held Friday, November 16th from 4:00pm to 7:00pm at the Lowe's Funeral Home located at 2205 S Church St. in Burlington.

The funeral will be held on Saturday, November 17th at 2:00pm at The Lamb's Chapel - Airport Campus located at 3539 Alamance Rd, Burlington, NC 27215.

Visitation will be held during peak traffic times along South Church Street. Burlington Police Department will monitor and assist in maintaining steady traffic patterns during these peak times. Motorist should expect delays along South Church Street Friday afternoon.

At the conclusion of the funeral on Saturday, a procession will occur ending at Berea Christian Church, located at 2828 Old HWY 87. The funeral and funeral procession is expected to draw a large attendance from the public and from statewide law enforcement agencies. The Burlington Police Department wants to make the Burlington community aware that some locations may be affected by traffic delays.

We also recognize that members of the public and of law enforcement agencies may wish to pay their respects to Officer Franks by standing along the funeral procession route. We encourage any motorist or pedestrian that does so, to please keep safety in mind.
