Burlington Fire Department Responds to Structure Fire – 1520 South Mebane Street

Burlington, NC – The Burlington Fire Department responded to a structure fire at 1520 South Mebane Street, on the evening of March 26, 2019. Units responded just before 5:45 pm and arrived on the scene in four minutes to find where a fire had damaged portions of the kitchen. Personnel responding verified all occupants including three children had evacuated the apartment. Fire personnel also confirmed the fire was extinguished upon their arrival and the fire had not spread to other areas or units.

Damage estimates are approximately \$10,000 to the structure and \$1,500 to the contents. The cause of the fire was determined to be accidental. A total of sixteen fire personnel responded to the incident. There were no injuries to firefighters or others reported. The Burlington Police Department, Duke Energy, and the American Red Cross assisted in the response to the incident as well.
