### **Burlington Fire Department Responds to a Fire at McDonald's – 1829 North Church Street**

**Burlington, NC** – The Burlington Fire Department responded to a structure fire at 1829 North Church Street, in the early hours of March 30, 2019. Units responded at approximately 2:15 am and arrived on the scene just four minutes later to find where a fire had occurred inside the restaurant. Personnel responding verified all occupants including patrons and employees were evacuating the building. Fire personnel also confirmed the fire was extinguished upon their arrival by employees who had used a fire extinguisher. Burlington Fire personnel also verified the fire had not spread to other areas of the structure.

Damage estimates are approximately \$500 to the structure and \$2,000 to the contents. The cause of the fire is still under investigation by the Burlington Fire Department and Burlington Police Department. A total of sixteen fire personnel responded to the incident. There were no injuries to firefighters or others reported. The Burlington Police Department assisted in the response to the incident as well.
