### **Renew Maple Avenue Corridor Initiative Public Meeting**

BURLINGTON, NC—The City of Burlington has contracted with the [Toole Design Group](#) to create a plan to revitalize Maple Avenue from Anthony Road to South Church Street. The Toole Design Group, City Staff, a Steering Committee of community stakeholders, and the public have worked together to develop a strategy for beautification, infrastructure improvement, and driving economic growth in the Maple Avenue Corridor. This initiative remains a proposed plan pending adoption by City Council.

A public meeting will be held at the Kernodle Senior Center on Tuesday, April 23, from 5:00pm-7:00pm that will include a presentation from the consultants from 5:00pm-5:30pm and then an open house for the remainder of the event. During the open house, display boards and aerial view maps will be available for attendees to view the proposed changes. Participants are welcome to attend either or both sessions and will be provided light refreshments.
