**Burlington, NC** –Over 250,000 passenger trips have been taken on Link Transit since the system launched on June 6, 2016. Link Transit will celebrate its third year of service by offering free fares June 3-7. Normal fares are \$1.00 with reduced fares available to students, senior citizens, and disabled individuals.

Link Transit will celebrate from 9:30am – 5:05pm on June 6<sup>th</sup> at the Temporary Transfer Hub with rider appreciation event. Join us for giveaways and birthday cake from 3:20pm-3:30pm.

Fare free week is a great time to try Link Transit for the first time! Link Transit currently operates five routes in Burlington, spanning from Gibsonville to Alamance Community College.
