JANUARY 6, 2021 - Due to a high volume of community members currently at the CTEC vaccine distribution, we have met capacity. The line is temporarily paused and new arrivals will be turned away. Capacity is determined by traffic patterns, safety concerns, and current staffing. Everyone who wants a vaccine will get a vaccine. The Health Department asks for your patience as operations ramp up and are streamlined. Vaccine distribution start and stop times will be available in real time on the Health Depart website (<https://www.alamance-nc.com/healthdept/>) and on [Facebook](#) (@AlamanceCountyHealthDept) and [Twitter](#) (@ACHealthDept)

As of today, only people 75 and over are eligible for vaccine distribution (Phase 1b – Group 1). People not in this group will be turned away without a vaccination. Registration will require: name, date-of-birth, contact information and demographic information.

540 Vaccinations were distributed yesterday, roughly one per minute.

Vaccine events will be held 7:00am-4:00pm Monday-Friday. Vaccine event is happening at Career and Technical Education Center (CTEC) located at 2550 Buckingham Rd, Burlington, NC 27217.

Attendees are asked to enter McKinney Street from the east bound lanes of North Church Street. Please be patient as lines are long as waits are can be multiple hours.
