LINK TRANSIT OFFERS FREE RIDES TO VACCINATE ALAMANCE CLINIC

Burlington, NC – Beginning March 1, Link Transit will begin operating the Vaccinate Alamance Shuttle from the Worth Street Transfer Hub to the new Vaccinate Alamance Clinic at 2401 Eric Lane, Unit 100 in Burlington. The Shuttle and any Link Transit rides to connect to the Shuttle will be free of charge. The Vaccinate Alamance Clinic is a partnership between the Alamance County Health Department and Cone Health. The Link Transit Vaccinate Alamance Shuttle is funded by a CARES Act Grant administered by the City of Burlington.

Residents may board on any Link Transit route, inform the driver that they are going to the Vaccinate Alamance Clinic, ride to the Transfer Hub, and transfer to the Vaccinate Alamance Shuttle at no cost. The Shuttle will take riders directly to the Vaccinate Alamance Clinic and drop them off at a designated Link Transit stop. The Shuttle will depart from the Vaccinate Alamance Clinic and arrive at the Worth Street Transfer Hub in time to transfer to the other Link Transit routes.

The Link Transit Vaccinate Alamance Shuttle will follow the schedule below.

Vaccinations at the Vaccinate Alamance Clinic are available to eligible persons by appointment only and can be scheduled through the Health Department at 336-290-0650. The appointment line is open Monday-Friday from 8:30am to 4:30pm or until available appointment slots are filled.
