### **Burlington Police Officer Bobby Davis named Crime Stoppers Coordinator of the Year by the North Carolina Crime Stoppers Association**

BURLINGTON, NC – On October 28, 2021 Burlington Police Officer Bobby Davis was named the Crime Stoppers Coordinator of the year by the North Carolina Crime Stoppers Association. Davis has served as a Burlington Police Department Officer for 21 years, spending the majority of his career in patrol and as a Community Resource Officer. Towards the end 2019, Bobby took on a new role as the Coordinator of the Alamance County Crime Stoppers program in addition to his current role as Burlington's Community Resource Officer.

The Alamance County Crime Stoppers program was launched in 1982 and includes the Burlington Police Dept., Mebane Police Dept., Alamance County Sheriff's Office, Gibsonville Police Dept., Elon Police Dept., Graham Police Dept., Haw River Police Dept. and Elon University. Since Bobby has become the coordinator, he has helped modernize the program, expand the Board of Directors, host the program's first fundraiser and works to continually educate the community on how Crime Stoppers works.

Davis has revamped and modernized the external presence of Alamance County Crimestoppers with the implementation of the mobile-app 'P3 Tips', which is the best way to submit tips anonymously for cash rewards. He has also revamped the [Alamance County Crimestoppers website](#) and created the [Facebook page](#) for the organization which has grown to over 7,000 followers in a short time.

Bobby is also a Board Member with the North Carolina Crime Stoppers Association and a great asset to the Burlington Police Department and the community he serves. Crimes Stoppers is integral in helping solve crimes in Alamance County and we encourage all residents to use this tool to "See Something Say Something".
