Make a Difference, Serve on City Boards and Commissions 2022 Appointments upcoming

BURLINGTON, NC—Applications to become a member of Burlington’s volunteer Boards and Commissions are currently being accepted. City Council will consider applications and make appointments in the month of June. Board and Commission terms begin on July 1st and are typically three years in length.

“Service on a volunteer Board or Commission is a great way to positively influence the future of your city,” says Community Engagement Manager, Morgan Lasater. “You can make a difference by attending one meeting a month.”

WHAT BOARD AND COMMISSIONS ARE OPEN IN 2022 APPLICATION PROCESS?

Nine of the thirteen boards and commissions will be eligible for appointment in 2022:

1. Alcoholic Beverage Control Board
2. Board of Adjustment
3. Burlington Housing Authority
4. Historic Preservation Commission
5. Minimum Housing Commission
6. Planning and Zoning Commission
7. Traffic Commission
8. Tree and Appearance Commission
9. Community Police Advisory Team
