### **Rides at Burlington's City Park Opens for the Season**

**Burlington, NC** – Hop on down to Burlington's City Park this Easter weekend and enjoy the train, car, and boat amusement rides. The amusement park and concession stand will be open for the season beginning on Saturday, April 16. The Amusement rides will operate this Spring on Saturdays and Sundays from 1pm-7pm. Expanded Summer hours will begin in mid-June.

The City's Historic Dentzel Carousel has not yet returned from restoration. Pandemic-related supply chain issues have delayed construction on the Carousel's brand-new Carousel House. The big, beautiful glass doors that will open and close with the weather are a specialized product that have been the primary hold-up. The City will have a ribbon-cutting celebration when the Carousel returns home and is ready for rides.

Due to Carousel House construction, the parking lot on Main Street near South Church Street is currently closed. Patrons can park in the large lot off Kitchin Street behind the YMCA and near Thataways Youth Center (1331 Overbrook Road).
