Paramount Theater hosts World Premiere of *The Last Boomer on Earth*

The play is the first of four plays by David Wright set for their world premieres

Burlington, NC – *The Last Boomer on Earth*, one of four world premiere plays by Paramount Acting Company Artistic Director David Wright, is set for production at the City of Burlington’s Paramount Theater June 23-26.

The play, set in the year 2073, tells the story of Frank Logan, a retired playwright and widower, is certified to be one hundred and twenty-three years old. He receives a visit from a young government researcher who informs him that he is the sole surviving member of the Baby Boom generation. During two of her visits, Frank attempts to explain and justify the actions and attitudes of his generation.

Three other original plays, *Peelin’ Peaches in Ossipee*, *The Last Night of the Oleander Pier*, and *WSSB* are scheduled for production later in the year and early 2023.

In addition, plans to expand and diversify Paramount programming include presentations of two national touring shows, “The Baby Boomer CLEAN Comedy Show” on November 5 and “A Celtic Christmas” on November 25. Theater officials are negotiating with other music and entertainment acts.
