

Alamance Junior Tennis Foundation Guidelines for Scholarship

1. Student must be in middle or high school in Alamance County. Scholarship may be applied for once a year. Applications will be considered throughout the year.
2. If awarded an AJTF scholarship, student must be willing to help in one of the following programs/tournaments:
 - a. Mentor the middle school tennis program.
 - b. Help with the *Huck Finn Junior Doubles Classic Tournament*.
 - c. Help with the *Aces and Deuces Tennis Camp*.
3. Funds will be awarded in amounts ranging from \$50 to \$500 per applicant depending on individual needs. The coaches have agreed to discount lessons of scholarship recipients. In addition, clothing and shoes will be awarded as specified by the applicant.
4. Upon receipt of acceptance letter the student must submit a plan for how the scholarship money will be spent. The student, his/her parent or guardian, and the student's coach must sign the plan for it to become effective.
5. Checks will be sent to the coach, program or organization for which they will be used in the applicant's name in accordance with the submitted plan. A member of the AJTF selection committee will contact the applicant when clothing and/or shoes arrive, so a pick up time can be arranged.
6. The following criteria will determine AJTF's selection:
 - a. Desire to learn and improve at tennis.
 - b. Financial need.
 - c. Grades/Attendance.
 - d. Extracurricular activities including athletics, clubs, church and community involvement.
 - e. Recommendations from Coach and Teacher. The recommendations must discuss the criteria above to help the selection committee gain more information about the applicant.
