Alamance County Emergency Alerts



Attention: The City of Burlington is no longer issuing CodeRED emergency or weather alerts. Alamance County is now providing emergency alerts for all County and City residents with publicly listed phone numbers. Visit **www.alamance-nc.com/firemarshal/get-alerts/** today to register and personalize your emergency notification settings. You can also text "ALAMANCE" to 888777 to begin receiving emergency SMS text message alerts immediately. At this time A.C.E. Alerts only provide tornado and flash flood warnings, but you can receive additional severe weather alerts by subscribing to the Weather Alerts category of Btown NotifyMe. Call (336) 227-1365 if you have any questions about A.C.E. Alerts or need to subscribe without a computer.

Btown NotifyMe

The City of Burlington has recently enhanced its public notification system to provide you with more customization. With Btown NotifyMe, you can now select what types of information you would like to receive from a more narrowly defined list. Sign up to receive information about animal services, police, athletics, senior adult programming, outdoor recreation, and more!



You can also choose to have this information delivered to you in the method that is most convenient for your lifestyle. You can register to receive a phone call, text message, email, or any combination thereof.

Hear the Beep Where You Sleep



Roughly half of home fire deaths occur as a result of fires that happened between 11:00pm and 7:00am. That is why the National Fire Protection Association and the Burlington Fire Department want you to know that smoke alarms save lives!

Smoke spreads quickly throughout a building and having a smoke alarm means having more time to get out of a burning home. Working smoke alarms reduce your chance of dying in a home fire by 50 percent. Not only is it important to have a working smoke alarm, but it is critical to have a working smoke alarm in every bedroom of your home, outside of every sleeping area, and on each level of your home, including the basement.

Leaf Collection & E-Waste Recycling

Loose Leaf Collection

As autumn arrives and the leaves begin to fall, **please note and retain this year's loose leaf collection schedule and zone map on the back page of this City Works newsletter.** Prepare your leaves for collection by 7:00am on the Monday of your scheduled collection week.

Please call the Public Works Department at 222-5005 or the Cemetery and Grounds Division at 222-5077 with questions or for clarifications related to leaf collection.



- Loose leaves should be piled behind the curb, or on the shoulder of streets without curb and gutter, **by 7:00am on the Monday of the scheduled week of collection.**
- Please do not pile leaves in the street, in drainage ditches, or over water meters.
- Do not park in front of or on leaf piles.
- Leaves which contain gravel, limbs, glass or other solid debris cannot be collected.
- Should you require more frequent leaf collection, you may place leaves in your yard waste container (no more than a 32 gallon container weighing less than 50lbs), or in clear plastic bags (weighing less than 50lbs) for collection on your regular trash day.
- Leaves can be collected on a “convenience schedule” during the month of February by calling 222-5005 to schedule a collection.

Electronic Waste Collection Event

City residents are invited to bring their broken and obsolete electronic devices to the City's Public Works Parking Lot, located at **234 East Summit Avenue** in Burlington, on **October 3rd** to be recycled at no charge. This free electronic waste recycling event will go on from **9:00am to 2:00pm**. Signage will be placed to direct e-waste recyclers to the correct location.

Home electronics, personal computers, personal electronics, and other miscellaneous electronic devices will be accepted. Batteries are not accepted and alkaline batteries must be removed from electronics before they are dropped off to be recycled. White goods, appliances, air conditioning units, and other non-electronic items will not be accepted. Call (336) 222-5095 or visit www.BurlingtonNC.gov/ewaste for more information.
